Recently the Minister of Agriculture of Republic of Indonesia issued a new regulation concerning the business licensing procedures for the agricultural sector. The purpose of the issuance of this regulation is to optimize the licensing services in the agricultural sector through the OSS (One Single Submission) system as governed by the previous regulation.
